Hello,

I surrendered my driving licence from 31.07.2015 because of a severe head injury that I suffered on that date. I subsequently had my licence revoked for 12 months - until 31.07.2016.

Prior to the expiry of my licence revocation I applied to have my licence re-instated - I think this would have been in May or June of 2016. It is now November and I still have no idea when my driving status will be reviewed - just a standard response of "it's waiting to be looked at by a doctor". It is now about 15 weeks since my "medical revocation period" expired but I am still no wiser about when I may be eligible to start driving again.

Could someone look into this issue with some urgency as it is having an extremely negative impact on getting my life back on track after suffering my serious injury? Could someone please give indication of when my case will be looked at, as I said earlier I have now been told since July that "it's with a doctor". I honestly don't know if 15 weeks, can turn into 15 months or 15 years - it is extremely difficult for me to make some life choices given my uncertainty.
